Programming

Alleluia Academy A fun and interesting way for 3- thru 6-year olds to learn about God with games, crafts, snacks and stories.



Drama Group This class will meet to practice drama skills and to rehearse and perform short drama skits for worship services. Ages 7 and up.



'Tweens Boys This group of 5th thru 7th grade boys meets in the Computer Lab to explore using technology to tell their faith stories.



Music

Bell Choir Meets in the Lounge from 6:00—7:00 to practice the songs that will be played in worship on the 3rd Sunday of each month.
