

Come and join the Choral Union in its 141st year for **ELIJAH**, an oratorio by Romantic German composer Felix Mendelssohn.

Elijah (German: Elias) is a large work for choir, chamber orchestra and soloists. Soloists are Alex Gmeinder, tenor, Brian Leeper, baritone, Sarah Leuwerke, mezzo soprano and Marie Severing, soprano. Elijah depicts events in the life of the Prophet Elijah as told in the books 1 Kings and 2 Kings of the Old Testament.

It premiered on Aug. 26, 1846, at Birmingham (England) Town Hall in its English version, conducted by the composer, and it was immediately acclaimed a classic of the genre.

This year's performance will feature a reduced orchestration of 18 recently written by German composer and instrumentalist, Joachim Linckelmann. The work is conducted by artistic director Richard Severing, in his 29th year.

## UNDERSTANDING 'PURPLE'

At a time of immense division, PURPLE presents a rare political conversation across divides that uplifts, provokes, and inspires while going toward the heat of passionate political differences.

A poll after the 2016 election of thousands of people in all 50 states found that 16% had stopped speaking to a family member or close friend over politics. This finding suggests the unraveling of 50 million relationships, simply because people disagree about politics.


We want to help reestablish links to those with whom we have fundamental disagreements. We offer an opportunity to gain inspiration around what we can do to help stem the tide of increasing polarization and division in our country. Participants watch a documentary called PURPLE, and take part in a guided discussion to learn how to reach across the divide.

Two groups of people from Cargill have already participated in this program, and most have agreed that it gave them tools and techniques to better understand those on "the other side".
