This year's graduates will be celebrated during the 10:30a service, including a special video presentation. Graduates please arrive by 9:30a for a group photo and please wear your cap and gown!

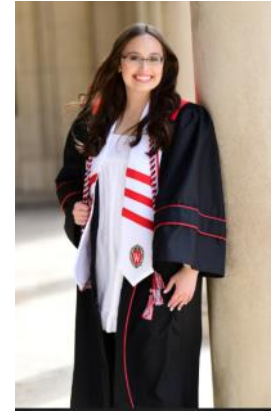

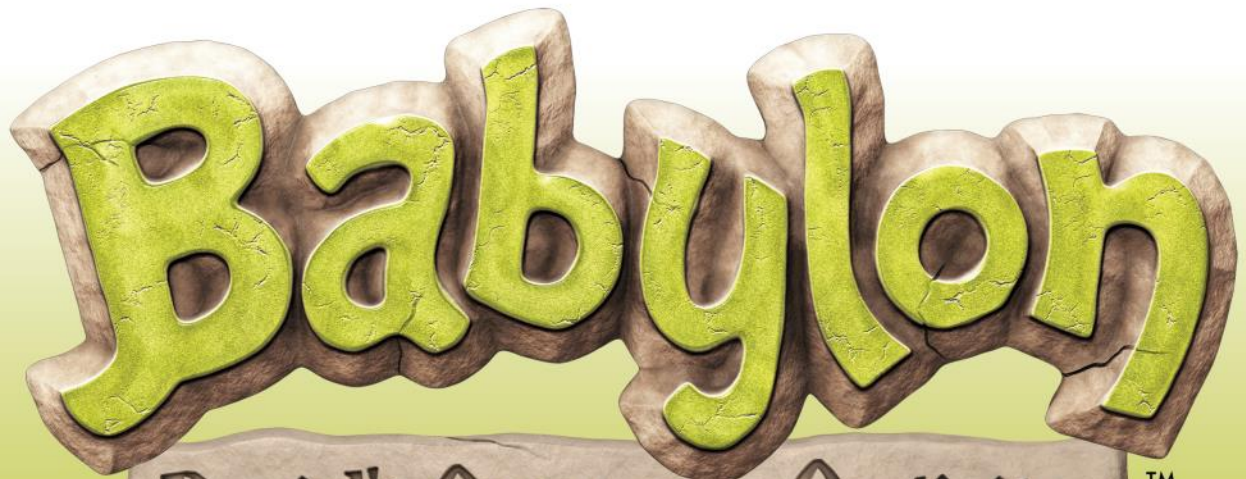
