

Cargill UMC members voted in November to say "yes" to capitalizing on the church's strengths and invite new people to connect with God and one another.

Here are the areas in which you're invited to become involved:

Lead Pastor Steve Scott and Discipleship Pastor Amy Powell are designing an invitation process for the entire congregation to participate as opportunities unfold over the next several months.

"This isn't a top-down process," Pastor Steve told nearly 100 members who met Nov. 2 to approve the next steps. "This is the church speaking and moving. Pastor Amy and I are here to lead you to dive in."

The prescriptions for next steps came out of Cargill's yearlong involvement with the Missional Church Consultation Initiative (MCCI). Cargill is one of a handful of Wisconsin congregations invited into MCCI. As a result, the church will receive coaching and resources to help members work in the above five areas beginning early in 2024.






BANNED BOOK CLUB—DEC 6




