The Gospel of John (the source of today's Scripture reading in worship) teaches that Christ is the means of

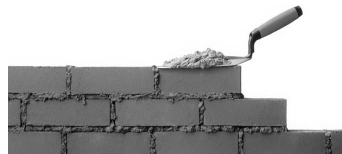
