

In honor of Mike's memory, Cargill UMC is collecting over-thecounter medications to help Fill the Pharmacy. Bring your contributions of new in-the-container medications to the Cargill Donation Center (in Narthex) between next weekend and April 4. Medications needed include aspirin, Omeprazole, Vitamin D3, Cetirizine, Famotidine 20mg, One-a-Day tablets, Loratadine 10mg, multivitamin, Vitamin B12, melatonin 3mg, 5mg, 10mg tablets, Vitamin B1, calcium 600mg tablets, calcium 600/ vitamin D3, Meclizine 25mg, Tylenol, Miralax packets and powder, Benadryl. Ibuprofen, FreeStyle Lite Glucose meter kit, FreeStyle Lite test strips.
