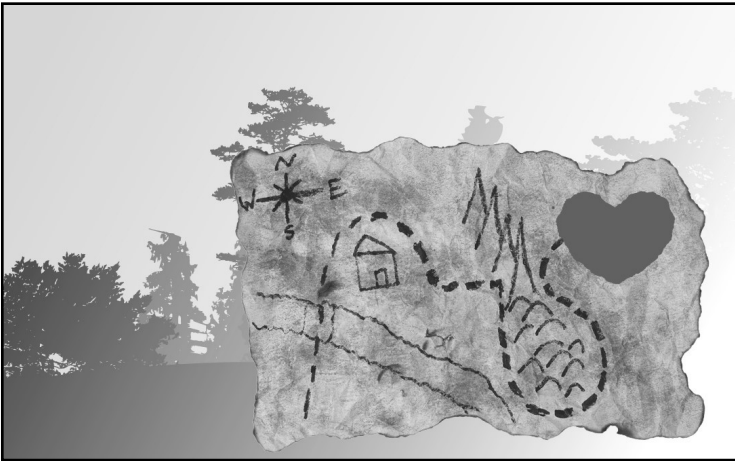

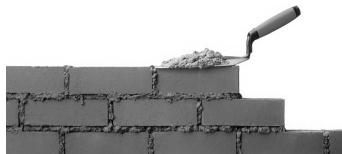

Fill the Pharmacy for Healthnet

HealthNet Free Clinic exists largely through the efforts of the late Mike Dow, for whom the pharmacy is named. In honor of Mike's memory, Cargill UMC is collecting over-the-counter medications to help Fill the Pharmacy. Bring your contributions of new in-the-container medications to the Cargill Donation Center (in Narthex) between next weekend and April 4. Medications needed include aspirin, Omeprazole, Vitamin D3, Cetirizine, Famotidine 20mg, One-a-Day tablets, Loratadine 10mg, multivitamin, Vitamin B12, melatonin 3mg, 5mg, 10mg tablets, Vitamin B1, calcium 600mg tablets, calcium 600/vitamin D3, Meclizine 25mg, Tylenol, Miralax packets and powder, Benadryl, Ibuprofen, FreeStyle Lite Glucose meter kit, FreeStyle Lite test strips.
