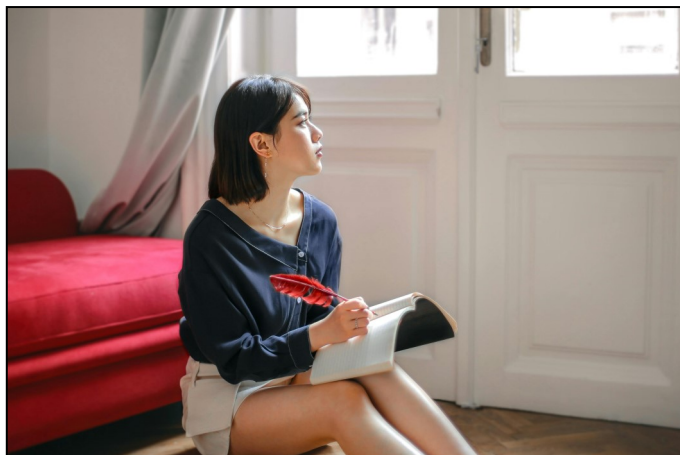

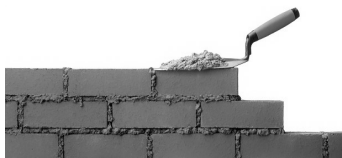
Faith Foundations
