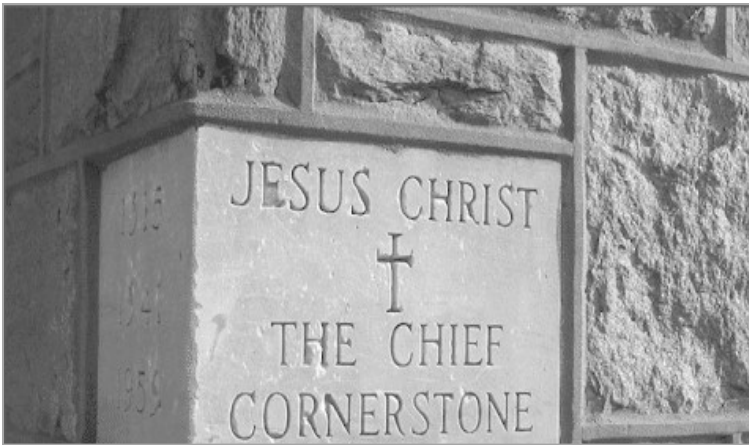

## Faith Foundations

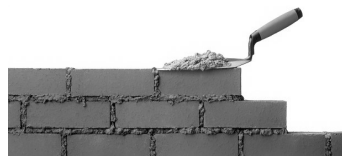
Why do people join a church? Maybe this: Because they want to connect with God and grow in faith. And then live it out in their daily life in practical ways.
