My mom and mother-in-law had the same best friend 40 years apart, but they never knew it.

Decades later, Carolyn and my mother-in-law, Nancy, were fast friends who met through their nearby UMC churches in Waukesha County.

Only after my mother's death did I come across correspondence that made the connection.

As did my mom and mother-in-law, their mutual friend Carolyn Boyden has dedicated much of her life to the United Methodist Church.

I still go to church?"

I want to share some of her words because I found them hopeful and true:

"Why do I still go to church in a world where fewer people choose to do the same? It is not out of habit. It is not because I want to be seen as 'holier than thou.' My reason is simple.

"In a world where we value our freedom, our privacy, and our independence, I don't want to be alone. I choose to be connected to a family of imperfect people who believe in the existence of a loving God, a people who face the darkness of the world honestly, but choose to keep their eyes on the light.

"These are people who want that light to shine in the lives of others. My church, for me, is where this happens. We may be at different places in our journey, but all are welcomed, and encouraged to go on, serving others as we can.

"Where ever you stand, whatever you believe, I urge you to find a place and community where you will not feel alone. If, deep in your heart, you sense that there is something, I don't know, a connective force, a source that calls us together, find a family. Find a church ... a community where you are welcomed and encouraged to help one another. That is why I go to church in a world where fewer people choose to do the same.

"Hope to see you on Sunday."
