Faith Foundations The Ascension of Jesus

The Ascension of the Lord has been church holy day for centuries, though not always in United Methodist congregations. In general, the day celebrates the completion of Christ's work on Earth and his entry into heaven .

When Jesus said his goodbyes and was taken up to his place alongside God in heaven, he conveyed yet another blessing on those he called and now leaves behind. That blessing was in the shape and identity of the Holy Spirit. (The Spirit gets its own holy day on Pentecost, which we will celebrate on May 23-24.)

"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you," Jesus says in today's Scripture (Acts 1:8). Jesus never leaves us powerless, but blesses us with more!
